

howdy. neighbor

This list contains questions you and your kids would like to ask your neighbors—within the bounds of decency, of course. How is this a *scavenger* hunt? You collect answers in the form of trinkets—ideally, ones that are fun for kids to get and painless for neighbors to lend or give way.

Give your child the list, collection bag, and pencil and explain that you're going on an adventure to find out more about your neighbors, and to collect a few small items from them. It's kind of like trick-or-treating . . . without the candy.

- Where's the coolest place you've ever been on vacation?** (Collect tourist map, foreign coin, or cheap souvenir)
- What's your favorite animal?** (Collect toy animal figure or dog biscuit)
- What do you like to grow?** (Collect flower or veggie)
- What was your favorite subject in school?** (Collect pen or pencil)
- What holiday do you like best?** (Collect ornament, decoration, or card)
- What do you like to read?** (Collect old magazine or book)
- What sport do you like best?** (Collect some kind of ball)
- Where do you work?** (Collect business card)
- What season makes you happiest?** (Collect calendar page)
- What food do you like best?** (Collect recipe or utensil)
- Do you have any collections?** (Collect a collectible)
- What is your favorite color?** (Collect anything in that color)
