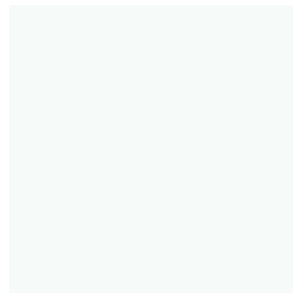
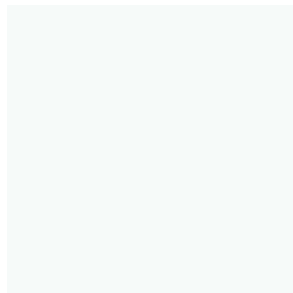
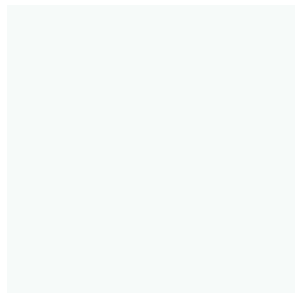
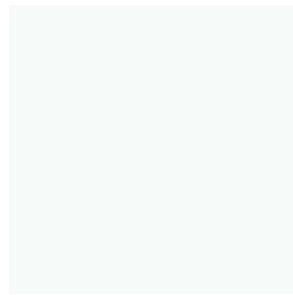
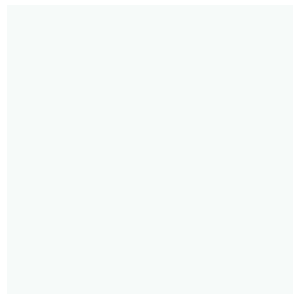
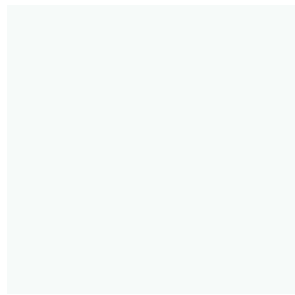
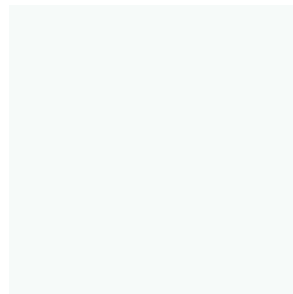
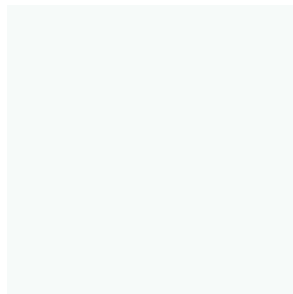
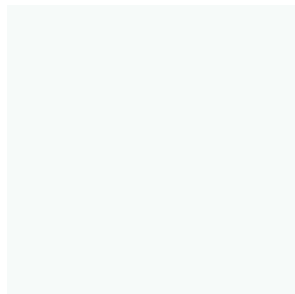


Make It Now
